Host a Storytime!

Make storytime party time with NOISY NIGHT!



Looking for a read-aloud complete with colorful illustrations, clever sound effects, and pages that will keep kids guessing? *Noisy Night* by *New York Times*-bestselling author Mac Barnett and gifted illustrator Brian Biggs is the perfect choice for storytime events.

Below are some suggestions for how to make this event special . . . and noisy!

Make some noise

Let your customers know that the event is coming! Included in this kit is reproducible promotional signage. Just fill in the time and date of the event, and display the signs around your store.



Get set up

Encourage kids to come to the event dressed in their pajamas. Make the reading area comfy (try arranging pillows or bean bags for kids to sit on). But don't worry about anyone actually falling asleep . . . this book is too noisy!

Provide snacks that kids can munch on noisily. Try chips for crunching and juice boxes for slurping!



Pro tip: Ask other local businesses to hang up flyers, too!

Fun and Games

While you're reading, encourage kids to guess who (or what!) is making so much noise on each page. After you've finished reading, ask the kids questions about the book: which noisy neighbor did they like the best, which one was the funniest or most surprising? Ask for volunteers to make their own noises and have the other children guess who they are.

This kit is full of fun things to do after storytime! Included are reproducible activities, an oversized poster for group coloring, and free lift-the-tab memory games for each child to take home.

Who is making all that noise? Match the noise on the left with the person or animal on the right!




















It's a noisy night in this city building!
